



OCEAN RIDGE JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB Registration terms and conditions

Ocean Ridge Junior Football Club aims to provide the very best environment for our kids to learn, play and most importantly ENJOY their Australian Rules football experience.

The participation of both the player and the parent/guardian in a manner that is conducive to the club providing this environment is therefore a condition of registration at ORJFC.

Volunteering

Our club is a Not for Profit organisation that is run entirely by volunteers. It is therefore compulsory for parents/guardians of registered players (as a minimum) to fulfil rostered game day roles as required by the team and the club.

It is the parent/guardians responsibility to communicate any limitations in their capacity to volunteer with the team Manager prior to the commencement of the season.

It is the parent/guardians responsibility to find a suitable replacement and communicate this to the team Manager if they are unable to fulfil a particular role that they have been rostered onto.

Where a parent/guardian actively volunteers in other roles for the club (eg coach/manager) the club will reduce (or remove) the parent/guardians allocation of rostered game day roles.

Code of Conduct

All players and parent/guardians are to abide by the clubs codes of conducts. Players must know and sign a player's code of conduct before they are permitted to play for ORJFC.

Parent/Guardians must:

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation, but don't force it.
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning.
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there to support not downgrade.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, umpires and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time.
- Never publicly criticise umpires – raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your family and yourself if you do – & many such comments are actually now illegal.
- Make suitable arrangements for the collection of players after training and ensure a nominated guardian is present at games.
- Inform the club /team manager of any medical condition your child may have and to provide medication for such condition

By registering with the club, parent/guardians must also (on their own behalf and for their child and all other parents, guardians or relatives of their child) abide, and be bound by the Club and League's rules and by-laws as published from time to time.

Fees

Registration fees are to be paid in full or an authorised payment plan entered into before a player is eligible to play for ORJFC. Payment of registrations does not guarantee any player a position at ORJFC. Final selection to play for ORJFC is subject to the ORJFC team selection policy.

A refund of registration fees is pro-rata until round 3. After round 3 no registration refunds shall be granted without the express permission of the committee based on mitigating circumstances.

Team Selections

Final ORJFC team selections are based on the Club's team selection policy. ORJFC reserves the right to select players in teams at its discretion and the Club's decision is final.

Waiver and Indemnity

"Football" means Australian Rules Football

"Club" means the Ocean Ridge Junior Football Club

"League" means the West Perth Junior District Council

"Child" means child or a ward at the club

"Players" mean the players at the Club

Playing Football, observing Football, learning to play Football and training to play Football and participating in any activity carried out by the Club are activities that inherently involve risk. In undertaking these activities players and their parents/guardians do so at their own risk. As a condition of any child's admission to a team at the Club, Players and their parents/guardians agree to absolve the Club's office bearers, officials, coaches, managers, umpires, members and/or agents from all liability arising from injury or damages howsoever caused. That injury or damage may arise out of membership of the Club, playing Football, observing Football, learning to play Football and training to play Football or negligence of any nature whatsoever on the part of the Club or League, their representatives, office bearers, officials, coaches, managers, umpires, members and/or agents.

Nothing in this agreement purports to exclude any liability that may be owed by the Club or the League and their representatives pursuant to the provisions of any Statutory Acts covering these activities. To the extent that any part of this agreement may contravene any of the Statutory Acts, that part of the agreement may be severed and rendered void but the rest of the agreement will remain valid and continue to have effect.

Privacy Collection Notice

Personal information collected by the Ocean Ridge Junior Football Club is for the primary purpose of membership requirements, competition purposes and football development. It will not be released for any form of commercial gain and will be maintained in a secure environment pursuant to the requirements of the Privacy Act. Completion and lodgement of Registration with ORJFC indicates acceptance of the terms of this Ocean Ridge Junior Football Club privacy notice.

Recording images of children participating in football, both photographic and videographic, is not permissible without the consent of the child's parent or guardian. However, all parents/guardians of Players at the Club are required, as a condition of Registration, to consent to photographs and/or other images of

Players being taken and produced during the football season by the Club or governing body and being utilised for the promotion and development of football by the Club and the governing body and being placed on the Club's internet site.

By signing this Registration Form, the person signing this Form acknowledges, consents and agrees, on their own behalf and on behalf of the stipulated Player, to the terms of the Privacy Collection Notice and Waiver & Indemnity set out above.

Acceptance of Terms & Conditions

By registering with the Club, Players and their parents/guardians are taken to have contracted with the Club for the instruction, training and playing by the Players of Football and are taken to have read, understood and agreed to the terms and conditions as set out in this document.
